

- A. Material: Native American Birchwood
- B. Wood is considered a safe material for use in ESD sensitive areas. (It is hygroscopic and has a low propensity for triboelectric charge generation under most conditions.)
- C. These tools are designed for holding, probing, and manipulating wires and components during assembly and soldering. Birchwood is hard enough to give a satisfactory service life, but soft enough that it will not mar delicate components and surfaces.
- D. Will not conduct electricity.
- E. Will not melt or deform at high temperatures.
