The MAX4950ACTX+ successfully meets the quality and reliability standards required of all Maxim products. In addition, Maxim's continuous reliability monitoring program ensures that all outgoing product will continue to meet Maxim's quality and reliability standards.

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- I. Device Description
 - A. General

The MAX4950A dual PCI Express® (PCIe) equalizer/redriver operates from a single +3.3V supply. This device improves signal integrity at the receiver through programmable input equalization and redrive circuitry with output deemphasis to correct for high-frequency losses. This device permits optimal placement of key PCIe components and longer runs of stripline, microstrip, or cable. The MAX4950A contains two identical channels capable of equalizing PCIe Gen I (2.5GT/s) and Gen II (5.0GT/s) signals. The MAX4950A features electrical idle and receiver detection on each channel and a power-saving mode. The MAX4950A is available in a small 36-pin (6.0mm x 6.0mm) TQFN package with flowthrough traces for optimal layout and minimal space requirements. The MAX4950A is specified over the 0°C to +70°C commercial operating temperature range.

VI. Reliability Evaluation

A. Accelerated Life Test

The results of the 150°C biased (static) life test are shown in Table 1. Using these results, the Failure Rate (λ) is calculated as follows:

 $\lambda = \underbrace{1}_{MTTF} = \underbrace{1.83}_{192 \times 4340 \times 48 \times 2}$ (Chi square value for MTTF upper limit) (where 4340 = Temperature Acceleration factor assuming an activation energy of 0.8eV) $\lambda = 22.4 \times 10^{-9}$ $\lambda = 22.4 \text{ F.I.T.} (60\% \text{ confidence level @ 25°C})$

The following failure rate represents data collected from Maxim's reliability monitor program. Maxim performs quarterly 1000 hour life test monitors on its processes. This data is published in the Product Reliability Report found at http://www.maximic.com/. Current monitor data for the G4 Process results in a FIT Rate of 0.32 @ 25C and 8.53 @ 55C (0.8 eV, 60% UCL)

B. Moisture Resistance Tests

The industry standard 85°C/85%RH or HAST testing is monitored per device process once a quarter.

C. E.S.D. and Latch-Up Testing

The AJ60 die type has been found to have all pins able to withstand a HBM transient pulse of +/-2500 V per JEDEC JESD22-A114. Latch-Up testing has shown that this device withstands a current of +/-250 mA, 1.5x VCCMax Overvoltage per JESD78.
